Effective immediately, the Moffat Water Supply corporation is implementing Stage 1 of the Drought Contingency Plan. Stage 1 of the plan requests customers to voluntarily conserve water and adhere to the prescribed restrictions on certain water uses.

(a) Stage 1 Trigger-

Requirements for initiation – Customers shall be requested to voluntarily conserve water and adhere to the prescribed restrictions on certain water uses, defined in Section VII-Definitions, when the total daily water demand equals 800,000 gallons for five (5) consecutive days, and/or when, pursuant to requirements specified in the Moffat Water Supply Corporation whole purchase contract with Bluebonnet Water Supply Corporation, formal notification is received requesting stage 1 of the Drought Contingency Plan, and /or based on "Table 1. Drought severity Triggers," Drought Contingency Plan Dated June 5 2007, Brazos River Authority (BRA), and/or the "safe" operating capacity of the water supply facilities (e.g. based on an evaluation of minimum treated water storage required to avoid system outage. Moffat WSC may devise other triggering criteria which are tailored to its system.

Brazos River Authority, and Bluebonnet have both implemented their Stage 1 Trigger. We have already reduced our usage due to low demand, we appreciate your cooperation in this matter. If you have any questions please contact me at 254-931-8773.
